## Bin 6000 Verdelho 2011



**REGION** Hunter Valley, New South Wales

**COLOUR** Light golden

**AROMA** Lovely tropical fruit aromas featuring peach and pineapple.

**PALATE** Verdelho is a flavoursome, refreshing and easy drinking white wine. This perfect example of the Verdelho varietal displays rich fruit flavours of honeysuckle, fruit salad and lime with a fresh, zesty finish.

**FOOD** A versatile white wine that is equally pleasing with appetisers such as shucked oysters or salads and mains including grilled chicken or smoked trout.

**NOTES** Verdelho is a Portuguese variety that is now starting to make its mark as a popular white wine variety. In the temperate climatic conditions of the Hunter Valley, it produces a distinct varietal wine with characters similar to Sauvignon Blanc and chardonnay.

To allow the full development of the fruit flavours, this wine was handled reductively with minimal skin contact, fining and filtration. After the fruit was crushed and the juice clarified, fermentation took place in stainless steel tanks at 14-16° Celsius to further preserve the delicate aromatics
