Region Hunter Valley, New South Wales

Colour Deep purple/garnet

Aroma A distinct Hunter Shiraz nose with typical cassis and

mulberry aromas coupled with earthy notes and coffee

char.

Palate A full bodied wine bursting with upfront dark berry

aromas. The use of oak provide delicate earthy, mushroom flavours and complement the intense fruit characters. Soft, fine grained tannins and a long finish

further highlight the quality of this wine.

Food This Hunter Shiraz would match well with a range of red

meat

Notes 60 year old dry grown Shiraz vines on the Bainton


vineyard in the Broke Fordwich area were used to make this wine further adding to the intense flavour characters. The grapes were crushed and must chilled in a fermenter where skin contact was given. After 6 hours juice was drained from the skins and transferred into a small

fermentation vessel. An aromatic yeast strain was used to

produce a wine in a white wine style.
